

“Close to 2”

Fraction Addition Game Directions

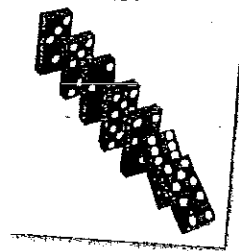
Supplies:

One set of double six dominoes with the zero set and the 1-5, 2-5, 3-5 and 4-5 removed.

Directions:

2-3 players

1. When creating a fraction using the dominoes, the end with the fewer pips becomes the numerator and the other end becomes the denominator.
2. Have each player choose two dominoes. Place one domino face up on the table and hold the other so opponents cannot see it. Players add the values of their two dominoes, trying for a sum of 2, without going over. A player with a low sum may pick one or more dominoes in hopes of bringing the sum closer to 2. Once a domino is picked up it must be included in the hand
3. When players are satisfied with their total, they reveal their hands. The player with the sum closest to 2 without going over, scores a point. (In a tie, each player scores a point) The dominoes used for a round are discarded. Play continues until all dominoes have been used. After a pre-determined number of rounds, the player with the greatest number of points, wins.



Extension:

Increase the difficulty of the game by returning the 1-5, 2-5, 3-5, and 4-5 dominoes to the set. Play the game using the previous rules.
